Prior to submittal of a Development Application, applicants must first hold a pre-application meeting with a Planner. To arrange a pre-application meeting, please call the Planning Department at (651) 675-5685. Applications submitted without first meeting with an Eagan Planner may be rejected upon submittal. Before submittal, it is recommended to coordinate with your Planner or Julie Strid, Planning Aide. Applications must be submitted in digital format (PDF only) to [Planning@cityofeagan.com](mailto:Planning@cityofeagan.com).

The above application dates apply to the following requests:

- Conditional Use Permit or Interim Use Permit
- Preliminary Subdivision
- Preliminary Planned Development
- Rezoning or Planned Development Amendment
- Comprehensive Plan Amendment
- Any other item to be reviewed by the APC

**Variance** applications must be received *three full weeks in advance* of the City Council meeting at which it will be considered.

**Final Planned Developments** typically go to City Council as a Consent Agenda item, but sometimes require review by the Advisory Planning Commission.

**Final Subdivisions** and **Final Plats** typically go to City Council as a Consent Agenda item without APC review.
