## **Open House to Discuss Goat Hill Park Shelter Building & Outdoor Rink Covering**

### **City to Host Public Meeting on August 21 at 7:00 P.M. to Gather Input**

On Monday, August 21, the City of Eagan will hold a public meeting to gather ideas from residents to improve the design of the Goat Hill Park Shelter Building & Outdoor Rink Covering.

- Phase 1 which includes the Pavilion/Rink Roof is currently scheduled to commence during the Fall of 2023
- Phase 2 includes the Park Building & Site Enhancements that would be designed this year, with construction planned for 2024.

Goat Hill Park is a winter play destination for skating, hockey, and more. A partnership with the Eagan Hockey Association allowed the City to install a refrigerated rink in the fall of 2022 to better support the community's winter activities. To expand the impact of this amenity even further, we will design a shelter and pavilion to make the space even more useful year-round.

The City of Eagan Parks and Recreation Department and Advisory Parks and Recreation Commission will host the public meeting in an open house format. Residents are encouraged to attend the meeting to gain more information regarding the process and share ideas. Your input is valuable and will be taken into consideration during the design process.
