

INFORMATION TO BIDDERS

2024 MUNICIPAL WELL REHABILITATIONS

City Contract No. 24-13

The City of Eagan is requesting bids for the routine inspection and maintenance services of three municipal wells. The quote(s) shall comply with the requirements described in this packet. Well and pump data is included for information only.

Project Scope

The major elements of work associated with the rehabilitation include, but are not limited to the following:

- Removal and rehabilitation of existing well pump and motor.
- Installation of rehabilitated well pump and motor.
- Removal and replacement of level transducers and tubing, adding 2nd tube.
- Video inspection of well.
- Rehabilitation of well by brushing and bailing of debris, as needed.
- Furnishing new equipment instead of rehabilitated, as necessary.

Please note the following:

- The term “bid” or “bidder” used in the specifications are interchangeable with the term’s “quote” or “quoter”.
- Familiarity with the site conditions is a quote requirement.
